(multiplier) as adjective/noun as...

This diamond is twice as expensive as that one.

There are three times as many people in China as in Russia.

...as adverb as...

That boy can run as fast as I can.

Call me as soon as possible.

...the same noun as...

Mt. Fuji is the same height as Mt. Hood. = as high as

James is the same age as Ichiro. = as old as

This shirt is the same price as that one. = as expensive as

Daniel: Have you ever been to Hokkaido in the winter?

Jennifer: Yes! I love it there at that time of year. There is snow **as far as** the eye can see.
