On

Used for days, and dates

At

Used for a particular time of day, or when using the word "night"

When are you the most hungry? Breakfast, lunch or dinner?

What time do you wake up?

When can you see the moon and stars?

From / To & Since

From/to are used to show the start and end of a period of time. Since is used to show the start of a time period.

When are you at work?

How long will you be in Tokyo?

How long have you lived in Japan?

When did you start speaking English?
